100 YEAR OLD CHOUTEAU BRIDGE DEMOLITION

THREE DIFFERENT FREEZING-COLD MORNINGS WERE SPENT ON A SANDBAR ALONG THE BANKS OF THE MISSOURI RIVER ... POISED FOR THE 3-2-1 COUNTDOWN, AND THE EXPLOSIONS THAT SENT EACH BRIDGE SECTION INTO THE RIVER. A short, CD-format, version was posted to the J.M. Explo website. A longer, VHS-format, videotape was presented to other project team members.

P-Tn ProgressCAMovie TIME-LAPSE RECORDING

A TIME-LAPSE 'MOVIE' WHICH COMPRESSES MONTHS OF WORK INTO LESS THAN A MINUTE; THE ORIGINAL IMAGES WERE CAPTURED WITH P-Tn's ProgressCAM On-Site 'Live' Internet Camera System, AT THE JOBSITE.

The CD-version was posted to websites for the owner & General Contractor. This time-lapse was also featured in a KC-B2B television episode about the architect.



KANSAS STATE CAPITAL INDIAN STATUE

THE ROOF OF AN ADJACENT BUILDING WAS THE BEST VANTAGE POINT FOR RECORDING THE 'LIFT' FOR 'FLYING' A BRONZE INDIAN STATUE TO THE TOP OF THE KANSAS STATE CAPITAL DOME IN TOPEKA. VHS and CD-format versions were edited for the J.E. Dunn Construction and the Governor's Office; a modified version was edited for the crane operations company - Wilkerson-Maxwell / APAC.

LOW-ALTITUDE AERIAL FLYOVER and PANORAMA

A HELICOPTER AERIAL FLIGHT AT A SPECIFIC LOW ALTITUDE ABOVE AN OFFICE PARK DEVELOPMENT LET US RECORD PANORAMIC VIEWS AS THEY WOULD LOOK FROM THE future TOP FLOOR OFFICE SUITES. On VHS-tape, a selection of panning rates were included with overviews of the entire OPUS Northwest project, to be used for sales presentations.



TOUR OF WORLD'S LARGEST DEEP COLLECTOR WELL

OUR VIDEO [and STILL] CAMERA ACCOMPANIED A GROUP OF VISITORS TO VIEW CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES AT THE BOTTOM OF A 150' DEEP COLLECTOR WELL IN KANSAS CITY, KANSAS. This is the largest collector well in the world (right here in Kansas) and the VHS Video was provided to the visitors as a remembrance, and used along with still photographs for marketing, by (GC) Collector Wells' International.

ELEVATED WATER STORAGE TANK ASSEMBLY

THE SEVEN HOUR PROCESS OF LIFTING THE WATER TANK TO THE TOP OF ITS CONCRETE PEDESTAL WAS RECORDED AND COMPRESSED INTO A TIME SPAN OF LESS THAN A MINUTE. Three versions [slow / medium / fast] were released on VHS-format tape and CD-ROM (mpeg) for web-posting, so Water One {and (GC) Landmark Structures} could demonstrate the procedure to interested parties.



P-Tn VideoRECORD DOCUMENTATION for STREETS & PIPELINES

A SHORT CLIP FROM A TYPICAL VideoRECORD TAPE, DOCUMENTING THE CONDITION OF CONCRETE AND LANDSCAPE AT PROPERTY ADJACENT TO A STREET OR PIPELINE CONSTRUCTION AREA. Multiple copies of our VHS-format VideoRECORDS are distributed to the engineer / contractor / owner, to provide an accurate record of PRE (or POST)-construction conditions and existing damage, in the event of disputes.

VideoRECORD UNDER BRIDGE DECKS & IN HAZARDOUS AREAS

OUR SPECIALLY OUTFITTED REMOTE OPERATION VIDEO EQUIPMENT PERMITTED US TO INSPECT AND RECORD THE CONDITION OF A BRIDGE SLATED FOR RENOVATION - FROM ON THE BRIDGE SURFACE. VHS-format tapes were utilized by the engineer in planning the renovation process, and controlling work volume. Tapes and CD-ROM clips were included with bid documents to clarify instructions to prospective bidders.
